
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























Art Enlightenment Class

Enrollment Eligibility

3-5 years

Every child should have an enlightenment period where they are interested in drawing and experimenting with materials. Open to young children who like to doodle and have a desire to express their ideas.

Class Objectives: 5 Modules, 18 themes

Guiding and inspiring students through thematic contents, lean and engage in creative activities

- 1.5 hours per week to complete a relatively simple piece of artwork or a small craft on a related theme, which is easy for children to accept.
- The theme of "sky's the limit" will make your child fall in love with drawing and painting. Dare to scribble, dare to do it, cultivate children's subjective ability to express themselves, use abstract forms to express concrete forms, reasonable guidance, no constraints and no control over children.
- We do not put pressure on children, but encourage them to cultivate their interest in painting, fully understand and accept the unsmooth lines and messy colors at the early stage of painting, and do not intervene in a dogmatic way, but give them more space to express themselves freely!
- Teachers accompany children patiently, so that children have a sense of security when drawing.
- Teaching speed is relatively slow, giving children more time and space when they come into contact with art, cultivating children's artistic aesthetics and color perception, stimulating children's creative nature, and guiding children to express themselves freely.
- Cultivate your child's patience and resilience.



Creative Art Class



Each class is 1.5 hrs, weekly

Semester Tuition: \$940

Enrollment Eligibility

5-7 years

This age group is the period when children's creativity develops. We welcome children who enjoy drawing and have a desire to express themselves.

Class Objectives | 5 Modules, 9 themes

- 1.5 hours per week, two weeks to complete a theme work.
- The theme of the course is creative, which increases children's interest.
- Creative Class focuses on painting materials and techniques: crayons, oil sticks, acrylic paintings and other materials.
- The intake of knowledge from different disciplines allows children to think, draw and do.
- Theme of each class: the first week focuses on knowledge development, group discussion, and sketching (focusing on the painting process); the second class learns about color, coloring techniques, the use of composite materials, and the completion of a complete work of art.
- Help children to harvest the surprise of color sensitivity, and cultivate children's awareness of basic colors.
- Use different auxiliary materials to let children feel different forms of creation.
- Guiding children to get rid of a brush stroke to follow the painting, the teacher will not help children to change the painting on the children's works, and actively guide the students to create their own work, to stimulate the implementation of the student's imagination.
- Enhance the child's awareness and ability to create. With rich imagination to create things, create symbols, really learn to create and express themselves.



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Master Art Class

7-9 years

Open to students who like to draw, but occasionally encounter small troubles when creating artworks. Open to students who want to improve their drawing skills and learn professional drawing techniques.

Class Objectives | 5 Modules, 9 themes

- 1.5 hours per week, two weeks to complete a theme work.
- Taking design and creation as the starting point, focusing on the creative process and mind mapping, students will develop the ability to think creatively and express their images, and learn to express their views with their works.
- The intake of subject knowledge in different fields allows children to dare to think, to draw and to do. Through modular technique teaching, students learn knowledge and skills.
- As your child's coordination and knowledge base grows, the course focuses on: artistic expression techniques, observation and painting expression, art appreciation and modeling ability, flat to three-dimensional space shaping, professional use of materials, learning watercolor and oil painting techniques, learning compositional proportions and color matching.
- Theme: The first week is based on knowledge development, group discussion, sketching and drafting (focusing on the process of painting). In the second session, we will learn about color, coloring techniques, the use of composite materials, and completing the work.
- Guiding children to observe things, establish the concept of threedimensional concept and the concept of light and shadow.
- Refuse to follow the painting, actively guide students to create their own, stimulate the imagination and creative ability, and truly learn the way of self-creation and expression.




